

Guidelines for WISE

- Internship duration of less than 60 days and more than 90 days (in counting) cannot be supported under the scheme of this programme. For e.g.

1st May 2020- 30 June 2020 (Right)

1st May 2020- 28 June 2020 (wrong)

1st May 2020- 29th July 2020 (Right)

1st May 2020- 31st July 2020 (wrong)

- From this year onwards no ZAV document is required for WISE Scholarship holders. As the programme supports less than 90 days internship duration. Therefore, no enrollment/Immatrikulation form is available on our website/ portal.
- Format of the LOR should be generated from the portal and filled by the referee. If there are any compatibility issues then the referee can contact the DAAD Team in New Delhi.
- There are two DAAD Forms (Approval Form by the German Host/ No Objection Certificate by home institution) available in the announcement to be uploaded by applicant on the portal. The portal opens 6 weeks prior to the deadline which is 1st November 2019.
- The internship duration has to match on the the Invitation letter, Approval Form and the NOC.
- While filling the application form on the portal please make sure that the personal details match with that on the passport.
- For those who don't have a passport at the time of application please make sure you have one latest by 1st December 2019.
- Hard copy of the Application Summary along with Letter of Reference should reach the Regional Office New Delhi latest by 5th November 2019.
- Confirmation/ Enquiries of receipt of Application Summary by the DAAD Regional Office will not be given via e-mail or call. Applicants are required to check the same via the courier company.
- The DAAD portal opens on 23rd September 2019.
